GUARANTEED TRANSFER PROGRAM APPLICATION

The Guaranteed Transfer Program

RCBC students in *certain designated programs* have the opportunity to earn direct admission into Rutgers University provided they meet the Rutgers admissions criteria and complete their Associate Degree at RCBC.

There are numerous options within the designated RCBC programs in *Liberal Arts; Science Transfer;* and *Engineering*.

Please consult with a RCBC Transfer Advisor for specific details about each of the guaranteed transfer major options.

RCBC students who fulfill all the required criteria will be assured admission, at junior status, to many majors offered at the following list of Rutgers University colleges and schools:

- Camden College of Arts & Science
- School of Business at Camden
- Newark College of Arts & Science
- School of Arts & Sciences: New Brunswick

Rutgers Admission Criteria

1. Completion of the designated AA/AS degree at Rowan College at Burlington County.

Please note: *All degree credits must be earned at RCBC or Rutgers University*

- 2. Attainment of a cumulative grade point average of 3.2, or above, at RCBC.
- 3. The course of study satisfies the general education requirements for a college of Rutgers University.
- 4. The course of study satisfies requirements for the intended major at Rutgers University.
- 5. Completion of all the Rutgers entrance requirements from high school.

Degree Requirements/ Time Limits

Students enrolled in the Rowan College at Burlington County - Rutgers University Guaranteed Transfer Program must complete the associate degree within three years.

Joining the Guaranteed Transfer Program

- 1. Students must sign the Transfer/ Guaranteed Admissions Program application *prior* to registering for their 30th credit at Rowan College at Burlington County.
- 2. Upon submission of the form, your name will be added to the Guaranteed Transfer Program mailing list.
- 3. While a student at RCBC, you are strongly advised to meet with a Transfer Center Advisor each semester to assure appropriate course selections that satisfy both graduation and transfer requirements.
- 4. Upon completion of 48 credits for your associate degree program at RCBC, you should make an appointment with the Director of the Transfer Center to review the Guaranteed Transfer Program process.

- 5. RCBC students who are enrolled in the Guaranteed Transfer Program with Rutgers University **are not permitted to change their intended major for Rutgers.** Therefore, you need to be very certain about your intended major in order to retain eligibility for the Guaranteed Transfer Program.
- 7. You are under no obligation to Rutgers University unless, and until, you choose to enroll at Rutgers. Participation in the Guaranteed Transfer Program means that you will follow a specific plan of study, **designed to match the core** requirements of an outstanding university. However, should you wish, you may certainly transfer to another institution.
