CALL TO ORDER

Board of Trustees Vice Chair Dr. James Kerfoot welcomed everyone in attendance and called the meeting to order at 5:32PM.

SWEARING IN NEW RCBC TRUSTEES

Vice Chair Dr. James Kerfoot introduced and welcomed Ms. Regina (Gina) Reed as a newly appointed Trustee to the Rowan College at Burlington County Board of Trustees.

Ms. Reed was appointed by the Burlington County Board of Commissioners at their meeting on February 9, 2022, for a four-year term to expire on October 31, 2025. Trustee Reed will replace former Trustee Jamie Martin whose term expired October 31, 2021. Ms. Reed is employed in the Office of the Superintendent for the Riverside Township Public School District, Riverside, New Jersey.

Also, Trustee Kevin Brown, whose term expired October 31, 2021, was reappointed by the Burlington County Board of Commissioners at their meeting on February 9, 2022, for a four-year term to expire on October 31, 2025. MINUTES

Vice Chair Kerfoot requested a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Board Meeting on January 18, 2022, as submitted. The motion was made by Trustee Kevin Brown, with a second by Trustee Dorion Morgan, and one abstention by Dr. James Kerfoot. The minutes were approved as written with nine in favor, one abstention, and none opposed. There were no questions.

REPORTS

1) President's Report:

The President's Report was presented in written form to the Board, which included news and events from January 18, 2022 to February 15, 2022.

- The On-Campus Crime and Fire Incident Report prepared by Captain Edmund Johnson was presented in written form to the Board for the period January 5, 2022 to February 2, 2022.
- President Cioce introduced Ms. Karen Albanese, Chair of the RCBC Foundation, who he invited to the Board Meeting this evening. Dr. Cioce shared that as Interim President and working with the College's and Foundation's Trustees, Karen Albanese quickly proved to the now President that she was extremely invested in the College. Ms. Albanese is an alumna of this institution, some of her children have attended RCBC in some capacity, and she has been vital to the success of the fundraising arm of our College's Foundation. Ms. Albanese assumed the position of Chair in February 2020 and her term has come to a close. President Cioce considers Ms. Albanese a friend and someone this institution is lucky to have in our network.

President Cioce proceeded with reading the proclamation recognizing Ms. Albanese's contributions to the College, and he presented the proclamation to her, a copy of which will be made part of the public minutes. Dr. Cioce also recognized RCBC Foundation Trustees in attendance, as well as members of Ms. Albanese's family. Chair Nyikita and the Board of Trustees thanked Ms. Albanese for her service to the Foundation Board, the College and the community.

- President Cioce announced that February is Black History Month and the College celebrated the return of an in-person fashion show in partnership with Atlantic City Fashion week. The show took place in the Student Success Center and was well attended.
- Saxbys' first student CEO, Owen Taylor, participated in the fashion show. President Cioce announced that the official opening date of the Saxbys Café is in March 2022. We will send more information to the College community and the Trustees as it becomes available.
- Give Kids A Smile Day also returned to an in-person event on February 4, 2022, and was an amazing success. RCBC's Dental Hygiene Clinic was filled to capacity. The clinic treated 40 patients with exams, cleanings, and any work that could be completed in one visit. The total value of the work provided to the children of our community by dentists and hygienists, some of whom are alum/students, was approximately \$23,000.

APPROVAL TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 STRENGTHENING CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION (CTE) FOR THE 21ST CENTURY ACT (PERKINS V) FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$492,172.00

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Rowan College at Burlington County (hereinafter referred to as Board of Trustees) received notification from the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE), Office of Career and Technical Education, that it is eligible to amend the grant in the amount of \$492,172.00 for fiscal year 2022; and

WHEREAS, Rowan College at Burlington County believes there is a need for funding to improve academic career and technical education programs; and

WHEREAS, fiscal year 2022 Perkins V grant resources will be used to improve teaching and instruction of College career and technical education programs in the Liberal Arts and Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics Divisions and student services. Perkins V funding will also be used for allowable activities related to career services, tutoring, student success, professional development and institutional research; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate student instruction, using relevant, up-to-date programming that meets business and industry standards, fiscal year 2022 Perkins V grant expenditures will focus on the purchase of equipment, instructional salaries, materials and supplies for academic programs such as: Health Information Technology, Geospatial, Human Services, Electronic Engineering Technology, Mechanical Engineering Technology, Nursing, Biotechnology, Diagnostic Medical Sonography, Culinary Arts, Radiography, Dental Hygiene, Fashion Design, Entertainment Technology, Photography, Cybersecurity, and Criminal Justice. The type of instructional equipment, materials and supplies that may be purchased includes industry-required equipment, laboratory supplies, print and database resources, instructional software and computers; and

WHEREAS, Rowan College at Burlington County agrees to amend the Postsecondary Federal/State Vocational Fiscal Year 2022 One-Year Spending Plan in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2022 Perkins V Grant Guidelines, and all other appropriate state and federal rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, submission of the One-Year Spending Plan to the NJDOE, Office of Career and Technical Education, and approval by the Board of Trustees are required for funding approval;
