



Intent to Transfer/ Guaranteed Admission Program Application

Rowan College at Burlington County Seton Hall University GUARANTEED ADMISSION AGREEMENT

Rowan College at Burlington County (RCBC) and Seton Hall University (SHU) have entered into this agreement in order to facilitate transfer from students of RCBC to SHU for the purpose of entering a baccalaureate degree program.

Eligibility

- 1. Students must sign the Transfer/ Guaranteed Admissions Program application *prior* to registering for their 30th credit at Rowan College at Burlington County.
- 2. Students must take *all* their credits at RCBC.
- 3. Students must follow an appropriate academic course of study for their intended major at Seton Hall University.
- 4. Students must complete their Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree at RCBC).
- 5. Students must earn a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 for most majors. However, several majors require a higher GPA. See list of majors for specific grade point average requirements.

Transfer of Credits

Through this program, Seton Hall University will guarantee admission to Rowan College at Burlington County graduates who have met the above criteria. Students will enter Seton Hall University with a maximum of 64 credits. Students must achieve grades of a "C" or better to have their courses accepted by Seton Hall University.

Please note that grades of "D"; developmental [remedial] courses; and excess credits will not transfer to Seton Hall University.

Degree Requirements/ Time Limits

Full-time students who wish to transfer to Seton Hall University through this program must complete the appropriate associate degree within 3 years of signing the Intent to Transfer form. Part-time students must complete the degree within 5 years of signing the Intent to Transfer form.

Students are expected to work with RCBC Transfer Center staff to create an academic plan that enables them to complete their degree within the required time period.
