**Hybird Mixed Mode (HMM) Courses for Spring 2021**

**ART Studios**

ART 110, ART 112, ART 120, ART 121, ART 122, ART 220

Students will meet on campus for 1 hour per week for lecture/critique as per the published schedule. Additionally, students are expected to spend 4 hours or more a week to complete studio coursework. Students will have the opportunity to sign up for instructor supervised on-campus studio time for a two-hour block. Additional work must be completed at students' own location and virtual support will be provided as needed by the instructor.

**Culinary**

CUL 216

Students will meet on campus for 5 hours every other week for hands-on activities. On alternate weeks, students who are not on campus will be responsible for reviewing course content and completing supplemental assignments in Blackboard for a minimum of 5 hours. Each instructor will send a schedule before the first day of class on which week students should attend in person.

**Entertainment Technologies**

ETS 105, ETS 225

Students will participate in a combination of on-campus instruction, remote instruction, and production fieldwork (at an off-campus studio location). Every week students will be required to submit work through RCBC's Blackboard learning environment. The instructor will provide a detailed course schedule at the beginning of the semester.

ETV 101, ETV 102, ETV 105, ETS 101

Students will participate in a combination of on-campus instruction, remote instruction, and production fieldwork (at student selected location). Every week students will be required to submit work through RCBC's Blackboard learning environment. The instructor will provide a detailed course schedule at the beginning of the semester.

**Fashion Design**

FAD 120, FAD 142

Students will meet on campus 3 hours each week for hands-on activities. Students are responsible on reviewing course content and completing supplemental assignments in Blackboard for a minimum of 3 additional hours each week.

**General Biology**

BIO 202

Students will meet on campus for 3 hours every other week for hands-on activities. Students who are on campus will spend a minimum of 3 additional hours on course content remotely. On alternate weeks, students who are not on campus will be responsible for reviewing course content and completing supplemental assignments in Blackboard for a minimum of 6 hours. Each instructor will send a schedule before the first day of class on which week students should attend in person.

**General Chemistry Labs**

CHE 116, CHE 118

Students will meet on campus for 3 hours every other week for hands-on laboratory activities. On alternate weeks, students will be responsible for completing a virtual lab assignment that should take at least 3 hours to complete. Each instructor will send a schedule before the first day of class on which week students should attend in person.
