GENERAL REQUIREMENTS AND NOTICES:

As a student in the RCBC/RU 3 + 1 program, I understand that:

- I am authorizing RCBC and Rowan University to share information about my educational records. The Rowan Relations Office will request information, like RCBC transcripts and grades, to be sent to Rowan University as needed.
- I am authorizing RCBC to declare AS or AAS in Advanced and Continuous Studies as my major, once I enter into the 3+1 Program as a junior.
- I am authorizing RCBC to graduate me from an associate degree upon completion of all required courses.
- I am responsible for providing Rowan University with official college transcripts from any college I attended outside of RCBC prior to senior year enrollment with Rowan University.
- I am responsible for reporting any credits or degrees earned at a college other than RCBC to the Rowan Relations Office.
- I am aware that courses taken in the junior year may not transfer to colleges other than Rowan University. If I leave the 3+1 Program, I must check with other colleges on their transfer policies.
- If I wish to leave the 3+1 Program, I must notify the Rowan Relations Office at **3plus1@rcbc.edu**.
- I am aware that I must follow the academic plan given to me by the Rowan Relations Office to ensure I am on track with transferring as a senior, and I am taking courses that transfer to Rowan University for my intended 3+1 major.
- I understand that RCBC will grant financial aid in the junior year, I must include RCBC’s school code (007730) on the FAFSA, and I must continue to follow the financial aid policies of RCBC.
- If I have an associate degree from a community college other than RCBC, this can make me ineligible for state funding in the junior year.
- I understand that I cannot receive part-time TAG during the junior year.
- I understand that financial aid has a maximum time frame requirement. I may have to appeal for financial aid after I attempt 90 credits or more.
