Also, be sure to include your military transcripts, which can be located at <u>https://jst.doded.mil/smart/signIn.do</u>

Complete the VONAPP application

- 2. Determine which educational benefit you will be using.
- 3. If you will be using the Post 9/11 GI Bill, you will need to submit your certificate of eligibility, which will be received upon completion of the application. If you are NJ Guard or reserve, you will first need to obtain a Commander's Certification. Once you have your Certificate of Eligibility or Commander's Certification, upload those documents to The Office of Financial Aid.

VFile your FASFA

1. You may be eligible for Federal and State benefits in addition to your military/veteran benefits.

After you are Accepted

- Schedule an appointment with a member of the Academic Advising team via <u>advising@rcbc.edu</u>, or myself via <u>dreeves@rcbc.edu</u>. If necessary, complete any placement testing.
- 2. Stop by The Veterans Center in Votta Hall, Room 134, So we can make an initial introduction.
